

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE NON-RESIDENT OR RECIPROCAL BROKER LICENSE APPLICATION

NOTE: This form is ONLY to be used when a person who holds a BROKER or BROKER/SALESPERSON license is reciprocating from another state, or applying for a license without reciprocity in the state of Mississippi. Mississippi residents who are licensed in another state wishing to reciprocate should use this form, and non-residents wishing to reciprocate should use this form.

Questions 1 – 2: This is the applicant's personal information. All correspondence from MREC is sent to the applicant's home address until they become licensed. If you cannot receive mail at your residence, you **must** provide your mailing address IN ADDITION TO your residential address. We must also have your email address. Be sure to provide a valid email address you have access to and regularly check in the event MREC should need to contact you.

Question 3: This is the address where the applicant will be conducting business. It must be a physical address. Post office boxes are not allowed.

Questions 4 – 11: Should be self-explanatory.

Questions 12 – 13: If you answer 'yes' to any of these questions, you **MUST** provide a SEPARATE statement regarding why you answered 'yes.'

Regarding arrests and judgments, "all facts" include:

- The date of arrest and result. Any jail time and/or probation should be listed with dates of when it was or will be completed. Both **misdemeanors** and **felonies** should be disclosed.
- The date of the judgment, the amount, and when it was or will be paid in full.
- If you are currently in bankruptcy, you must send a copy of your petition/schedule. If you have been discharged, you ONLY need to send a copy of the discharge paper.

Questions 14 - 21: Note that some questions have multiple parts. Be sure to answer all questions fully.

Question 22: This is for your PERSONAL bank accounts.

Recommendation of Three Real Estate Owners: If you do not live in the state of Mississippi or haven't lived in Mississippi for long, you are not expected to know three Mississippi real estate owners. You should have people who have owned property for at least three (3) years sign this. It is preferable that they be in your state, but not required. You may copy this section if you need to mail it to someone. Just be sure to include all ORIGINALS with your application to MREC.

Photos of applicant: You MUST include a full face and a profile (side view) face photo with your application. The photos are not required to be any certain size, but the MUST be clear.

Supplement, Pledge/Certification Forms, and New Broker Address forms: If you are a resident of Mississippi, you complete the Supplement to Application for Reciprocal License for a Resident of Mississippi. If you are NOT a resident of Mississippi, you complete the Supplement to Application for Reciprocal License for a Non-Resident of Mississippi. DO NOT COMPLETE BOTH SUPPLEMENTS.

ALL applicants **MUST** complete the Pledge/Certification form.

ALL applicants **MUST** complete the New Broker Address Form. ONLY ONE section should be completed (either Section A or Section B). If you will be operating as your own broker, complete Section B. If you will be operating as a broker/salesperson under another responsible broker, complete Section A. The responsible broker MUST be a licensed Mississippi broker. The distance between the broker/salesperson and responsible broker CANNOT be

MORE than a 50 mile/1 hour drive distance. If the distance is GREATER, the applicant will either need to select a different, closer responsible broker, or the responsible broker will need to open a branch office at a location within that distance limit for the applicant broker/salesperson to be licensed to. **IF** the broker is requesting to change the business address to their PERSONAL HOME, a copy of a **privilege license** from the city or county (if the home is not in the city limits). If the home is in a covenanted subdivision, we will need a copy of the covenants showing home businesses are allowed, or a letter from the HOA granting approval to operate a business from the home. **This information must be sent with the application.**

Application for Brokerage Firm and the Branch Office License Application: Not all applicants will need these forms. If you have a company name you plan to do business under and advertise in Mississippi, you must apply for a company license with the Application for Brokerage Firm. The Branch Office License Application is **ONLY** used if a SECOND office will be opened also.

BEFORE MAILING, BE SURE THE FOLLOWING HAVE BEEN ADDRESSED:

- Application **MUST** be typed or printed. If it is printed, be sure handwriting is VERY CLEAR. MREC is not responsible for any misprints due to illegible handwriting.
- **ALL** questions have been answered in their entirety.
- The application fee is included.
- If you have not done so already, you **MUST** contact MREC **PRIOR** to submitting your application if you are reciprocating to Mississippi for any SPECIFIC reciprocal requirements of your state. Requirements vary greatly by state, and are not listed on our website.
- Current E & O coverage must be included. E & O must be in the applicant's name, with Mississippi listed as a covered state, and a deductible listed not to exceed \$2500.00. Endorsements are not accepted from Tennessee.
- **ALL** certifications of licensure have been included. You **MUST** include a certification from every state you have **EVER** been licensed in, regardless of the current status of that license. This is **NOT** a copy or your original real estate license. This is a certification you must order from that state regulatory agency. All certificates of licensure submitted to MREC must be received by MREC within 60 days of the notary date.
- If you are currently licensed as a broker/salesperson under another responsible broker, you must include a letter of recommendation from your current broker. The letter should be less than 60 days old when received by MREC. Send the original letter.
- The letter from your bank should be in reference to your personal banking accounts (not business accounts), confirm the banking relationship, and verify that the applicant is in good standing with the bank. The letter should be less than 60 days old when received by MREC. Send the original letter.
- The application must be notarized and must be received by MREC within 60 days of the notary date.
- You **MUST** send the **ORIGINAL** application. A copy or scan (even in color) will **NOT** be accepted. Also, all signatures must be the **ORIGINAL** signatures. Digital signatures are **NOT** acceptable.

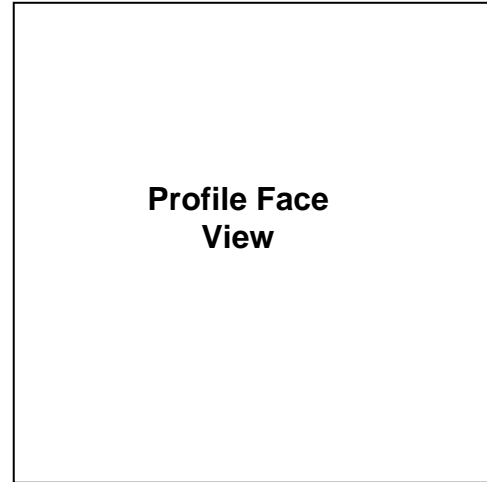
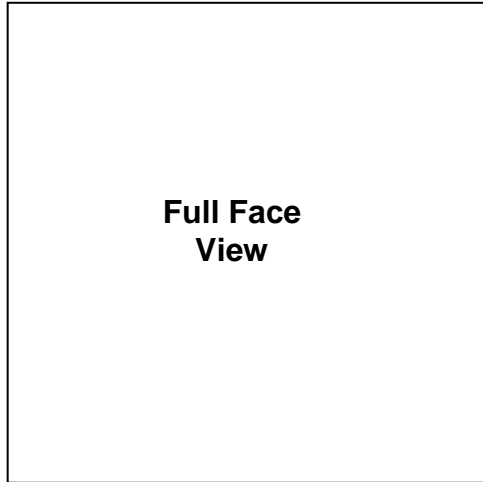

After obtaining the license, I understand that I must abide by the Mississippi Real Estate Brokers Licensing Act of 1954 as Amended and its Rules and Regulations while I am conducting real estate activity for which the real estate license is required, involving Mississippi real estate.

NOTE: This form is ONLY to be used when a company is opening a SECOND office (AKA: satellite office). If the COMPANY does not already have a license in Mississippi, a branch office CANNOT be opened.

Questions 1 – 3: This information is for the broker's name, the current location of the primary company license, and the company name.

Question 4: This is the address and information for the NEW BRANCH location being applied for. A residential address is NOT acceptable.

Question 5: The MANAGING broker and the RESPONSIBLE broker can ONLY be the same IF the new branch office is WITHIN a 50 mile/1 hour drive radius of the current main company location. If the distance is GREATER, the responsible broker MUST have an associate broker licensee to place in the new branch office to act as the managing broker for that location.

- The application fee is included.
- A branch office **MUST** have at least **ONE** other licensee at that location other than the responsible broker in order to become a licensed branch. If the broker wishes to transfer a current agent from the primary or another branch location to the new one, the broker may request the transfer by a separate letter (to be attached to this application) signed and notarized requesting to move the named licensee from (specify current location) to the new branch office. **THE ORIGINAL WALL LICENSE AND A \$50.00 TRANSFER FEE MUST BE INCLUDED.** If the licensee to be in the new branch office is transferring to the broker and firm from another responsible broker, complete the appropriate broker or salesperson transfer application, return the original license, and include the \$50.00 transfer fee.
