If placed "inactive" you must cease all real estate activity for which a license is statutorily required and you then must complete the license reactivation process.

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IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Notice of Fingerprint-Based Criminal History Records Check

Effective July 1, 2016, the Mississippi Real Estate Commission (MREC) requires that all applicants for a Mississippi real estate broker's license or a real estate salesperson's license, including nonresident licenses, and all applicants for renewal of any real estate license, shall undergo a fingerprint-based criminal history records check of the Mississippi central criminal database and the Federal Bureau of Investigation criminal history database.

Mississippi law, as amended by the Mississippi Legislature and effective July 1, 2016, provides that, in order for an applicant to qualify for a Resident or a Non-Resident real estate broker's license or real estate salesperson's license, and for the renewal of any existing license, an applicant must have been cleared for licensure through an investigation which determined that the applicant does not possess a background which calls into question public trust and a verification that the prospective licensee is not guilty of or in violation of any statutory ground for denial of licensure (Miss. Code Ann. §73-35-21). (See also, Miss. Code Ann. §§73-35-7, 73-35-8) and particularly (Miss. Code Ann. §§73-35-10). Provided all renewal fees, continuing education (CE) requirements and fingerprint cards (with fee) have been received by the MREC, the renewals for licensees who are otherwise in good standing will not be delayed pending the MREC's receipt of the results of the background check.

Submission of Fingerprints and Fees

- **APPLICANTS** - Enclosed with this Notice is a Fingerprint Card and Consent Form: In order to have your fingerprints affixed to the Fingerprint Card, you must take the card to a Law Enforcement Office that offers fingerprinting services for background checks or a UPS store. If you are unsure of the entity/location that offers fingerprinting services in your area, you should inquire at the local Police Department or Sheriff's Office. If you wish, you may make an appointment to have your prints taken at the Mississippi Real Estate Commission office in the Lefleur's Bluff Tower. Please call or email to schedule an appointment. Fingerprints are taken Monday through Friday from 9:00 AM – 11:00 AM or 1:00 PM – 3:00 PM.
- **PLEASE NOTE: You are responsible for the payment of any fees that may be required by the Law Enforcement Authority at the time your fingerprints are affixed to the Fingerprint Card.**
- **RENEWALS** – There will not be a fingerprint card enclosed because we should already have your prints on file and those prints can be used to run your background check. We will still need the reauthorization form as well as a \$50.00 check or money order made payable to MREC to complete the background check.
- A self-addressed envelope is enclosed which will allow you to return the completed Fingerprint Card, the Consent Form and a \$50.00 check/money order made payable to the MREC.
- **Please do not bend the Fingerprint Card.**

When received, the MREC will submit your completed Fingerprint Card to the Department of Public Safety Criminal Information Unit (CIU) to process the background check of the Mississippi and Federal databases.
